11. UEPC Update-Goal and 90 Day Turn Around School Plan

Exceed our goal of 42% of increased talk in the classroom to 44%. Next goal will be 50% of students will respond to questions or participate in partner or team talk in complete sentences as well as extend their talk. During data collection by UEPC scheduled on February 7th, the school exceded their goal by 19 points. 69% of Bennion students were engaged in student talk. The next focus will be to have student talk in all content áreas. Teachers will intentionally plan to ask question for students to discuss in small groups or individually. These questions will be tied to the lesson objective or essential question for the lesson.

New 90 Day Plan from February to April

The new 90 day plan is underway with a focus on reciprocal teaching as a strategy to engage students in student talk. First training was on January 26th. Bennion coaches facilitated the

training for teachers. A follow up training was conducted at the February 12th faculty meeting. Teachers were given a chapter to read from the John Hattie book in advance. Teachers were assigned to a group and each group member was assigned a role. This exercise provided teachers an opportunity to practice using reciprocal teaching as a tool to enhance student talk and collaboration while working in a group. On February 20th and February 27th teachers will meet with UEPC to develop a plan to start using reciprocal teaching in their classrooms. Following this training with UEPC teachers will begin implementing reciprocal teaching in their classrooms and will designate their classroom as a Learning Lab as they are teaching their students the process. By April 6th all classrooms will have had an opportunity to use reciprocal teaching in their classroom. Refinement of the reciprocal teaching process will continue through the months of March and April. The end goal is to have the process used in each classroom on a consistent basis to engage students in learning the skills they need to be effective readers, listeners, communicators and collaborators. Faculty meetings will be used for continued training and support and to share Big Wins teachers are experiencing in their classrooms.
