Computer lab upkeep: Posting new rules to help keep it clean. New privacy screens in lab.

Principal Louie:

Elementary schools cannot have paid sponsors or have vendors outside the school. Peach jar sends out flyers on behalf of the district for outside vendor sponsored activities. Parents can change their email settings to receive fewer emails through Peach Jar.

Excellence and Equity plan update: main for us is special education and non English language learners. 3 year priorities:

- Increase faculty support for SCC and PTA
- Increase community partnerships
- High expectations for all students. Want to increase DIBELS scores and focus on DRA's. Trying to be more targeted with academic help.
- Teachers are working on sending less homework home with students.
- Focusing on the mental health of students. Incorporating more mindfulness in the classrooms. Mindfulness
 is working. And the school is seeing positive results.
- Goal 80% of kids would have a 20% achievement growth. K-2 has reached the goal. 3-6 has 70% students
 reach this goal. Special education students have all met this goal. So far, the testing data is looking good
 this school year.
- Action steps:
- 1. Monthly grade level meetings to review data and adjust instruction.
- 2. Continue interventions for FOCUS students and monitoring weekly.
- 3. Continue school wide interventions for ELL and SPED students.

This new three year EEP plan is beneficial to the schools to help develop and reach goals.

Staffing Changes:
