Welcomed parents

Parents asked questions about the school emergency plan and where the off site meeting location was.

Mrs. Bergera gave them the address of the LDS church house located at 1301 S 1200 W.

Ms. Ines and Mrs. Cortez shared a presentation about AVID and what it means to be an AVID school. They also discussed digital literacy and what we do at the school to keep students safe when it comes to technology. Parents were encouraged to follow up with their students at home on what they are doing on the internet and with social media.

Ms. Ines asked parents what they wanted to discuss at the next meeting on December 6<sup>th</sup>.
