- Land Trust-Budget-\$43,197, targeted at hiring a computer lab para, which we are offering full-time and benefits for this year, and for math supplies
- Enrollment numbers are up this year and our EE classes need more paras as many are short staffed, we can hire 3, and if they are highly qualified, they can be hired for 40 hours a week/SpEd is having trouble hiring paras as well as teachers, the district currently has 15 unfilled teacher jobs
- School Report Card- We received a C but were only 4 points off from a B/Were exemplary in improvement/math definitely needs to improve but reading also needs attention/ some teachers are offering after-school tutoring for those subjects/ELLs are presently at typical which is an improvement
- Attendance- now that the moratorium is lifted, letters are going out to those who are not attending school enough as well as other interventions
- Crossing guards- St. Govt. students are doing the crossing guard
 jobs/some people, especially parents are crossing wherever they want,
 and several have been quite inappropriately rude to the kids/Fran will
