- Review Minutes:

- Membership & Leadership of SCC –
 - Signups during registrations, everything previously has been filled by volunteer signup.
 - We will review in the fall after registration to ensure all areas within the boundary are covered.
 - We will have leadership nominations and voting in the first meeting in the fall.
- Safe school walking plan review:
 - Earl is going to ask the SLC streets dept. to do a survey on the 1300 S crossing by Oak Hills Way.
 - EBCC continues to discuss road cycling on Wasatch drive and bicycles stopping at stop signs.
- Land Trust Plan
 - Committee finalized the land trust plan and sent it into the Administrator.
 - The plan was reviewed by the board, there were no recommendations sent back.
 - Committee Members will receive an email from Land Trust (Paula Plant) requesting an electronic signature on the Indian Hills Land Trust plan
- EEP Review – (replaces the SIP)
 - This is the first piece of feedback, we will also receive feedback from the board which will arrive in early May.
 - Once we receive feedback from end of level testing in the fall we will come up with the goals for the year.
- Wellness Plan
 - PE is marked sometimes – the district recommends 150 min a week, Indian Hills is doing 30-45 min a week. Indian Hills has both a morning and afternoon 15 min, and a lunch recess.
 - Snacks in classroom is marked sometimes as there are currently no restrictions in classroom snacks.
 - Concern expressed with lunchroom timing. Earl confirmed there is 20 minutes for lunch for each grade.
- PTA report:
 - Largest upcoming event is Art Night. They are looking for auction items to be donated for a silent auction. Classrooms are also putting together baskets this year to be sold also.
 - Volunteer Luncheon is coming up in May, all parent volunteers in the school are invited, not just PTA.
 - Becca Moore has setup an Instagram account for Indian Hills. PTA will manage it going forward.
 - Registration is going on right now. We will be selling discount cards at the registration and also Art Night and other back to school or registration nights.
- Other Business:
 - Earl is not retiring yet.
 - After School & Summer Tutoring
 - Summer tutoring paid through Land Trust Funds begins with a teacher recommendation. The purpose will be to teach foundational skills or correcting misinformation, and the teachers will communicate to the parents.
 - There is an opportunity to communicate that better to parents throughout the year. It will be brought up at back to school night.
