Acadience Reading is a universal screening and progress monitoring assessment that measures the acquisition of early literacy skills from kindergarten through sixth grade.

- Proficiency Goal

By June 2024, 63\% of kindergarteners will be reading on grade level as measured by Acadience Reading with a composite score of 145 or better.

- Growth Goal

By June 2024, at least $60 \%$ of K-3rd students will make
Typical or Better Progress according to Acadience Reading Pathways of Progress.

- Hire two paraprofessionals dedicated to our kindergarten teachers and one for grades 1st-6th to provide additional support for struggling students in the area of reading to impact student growth.
- Budget: \$50,842.00

## Calendar Options

Option 1 (9) is the traditional model with a two-day fall break, two-week winter break, and a one-week spring break. The first day of school is at the end of August and the last day of school will be in June. Five teacher contract days are scheduled prior to the start of the school year.

Option 2 has a week earlier start date and the last day of school will be in June. It still has a two-week winter break and a one-week spring break but increases fall break to one-week. Four teacher contract days are scheduled prior to the start of the school year and the fifth teacher contract day is in March.

Option 3 (13) has a week earlier start date and an earlier end date. It has a two-day fall break, a two-week winter break, and a one-week spring break. This means the school year should conclude before June. Five teacher contract days are scheduled prior to the start of the school year.
