School Compact	Caryn Willardsen, administrative intern, led a review and discussion of the School Compact. Copies of the compact were handed out to all participants. A student survey will be completed

	in class to contribute to the “Students” section of the compact. A parent survey will be distributed through email and available for completion during SEPs. The School Compact will be updated using survey feedback by late fall.
SCC Chair Meeting Update	Janet Barnette shared her experience attending. The focus was how Land Trust Funds are spent.
Administration Update	<p>Larry Madden gave the following updates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• They have had a great start to the year</li> <li>• The September 27<sup>th</sup> non-student day used for professional development will include a half day training from the district and a school training of “Happy Class” by Shelly Halverson.</li> <li>• Delta Airlines is flying 42 female students and 4 faculty from Bryant to Houston on October 5<sup>th</sup> for a day of Women Inspiring Aviation. The Today Show will also be present. Students were recommended by math and science teachers.</li> <li>• New Staff this year include math teacher Kiersten Thorsen and counselor Caroline Ingraham.</li> <li>• Bryant’s Well Being team is providing group therapy as well as individual therapy. School and parents can refer students for services. A district therapist Melissa will also provide services part time at Bryant.</li> <li>• Jean Garcia, a prior aftercare coordinator, is returning to Bryant as a Choose Gang Free Advocate.</li> <li>• Bryant was at risk of losing breakfast for all, however 200+ students have been taking advantage so it should continue to be provided. Bryant will remind families.</li> <li>• The Academic Bus is provided for students staying for tutoring or after school sports until 4:30.</li> <li>• Erica Marks-family/school collaboration, Bryant will have someone ???</li> <li>• Bryant student, Keo Williams, built a pigeon loft for Bryant to training pigeons with Dr. Stringham and the Racer Pigeon Society.</li> <li>• A \$20,000 grant for classroom sets of books has been submitted to SLCS; \$15,000 for Bryant and \$5,000 for SLCS, although books can be shared between the schools.</li> <li>• Home visit initiative to have teacher pairs visit families. Families are selected randomly, but visits are voluntary for families.</li> </ul>
