- 1. Minutes: Phong moved to approve the minutes, with minor edit to reflect that Roshawn was not at the last meeting, Keli seconded.
- 2. SIC Report: Back to school night is August 29, 2022. The SIC is trying to secure one-to-one computer ratios, if possible, for next year and will be updating the school rule posters. Tom is meeting with BOOT to discussing funding.
- Principal's Report:
 - a. Next school year, the SLCSD elementary schools are moving to a quarter system, although it won't change the calendar.
 - b. The group discussed the Open House, held on April 13, and Art Night, held on May 12.
 - c. May is a big month for end of year testing. Teachers will let parents know when each class tests so that the kids can be prepared.
- 4. School Trust Land Plan presented by Tom (recap from last meeting):
 - a. Goal 1: 5% increase in RISE testing (or other equivalent tests) in science. To achieve this goal, IHE is allocating \$17,400 of the trust land monies for hands on science.
 - b. Goal 2 (Gap goal): 5% increase for the lowest performing students in science, math, ELA. To achieve this goal, IHE is allocating \$31,000 of the trust land monies for a paraprofessional to support special education and small groups.
- 5. Changes in staffing:
 - a. Roshawn will not be SIC chair next year and thus not be on the SCC.
 - b. Elliot may also not be returning (although is happy to continue).
 - c. Ben Lowe will be the PTA president for next year.
 - d. Conrad gave his two weeks (last date April 22) and will not be returning as the PE teacher.
