January 2021 SCC Meeting Minutes 01/19/21

We accepted the December minutes with one correction.

We decided to jump right in and start discussing the re-enter plan for in-person teaching. Right now we are at 55% coming back. There are several things that have been put in place to ensure the safety of the students, faculty and staff.

- Everyone in the building will be required to wear masks at all times, with the exception of eating lunch.
- A disposable mask will be given to those that forget theirs.
- The drinking fountains are not to be used. Each student will be given a water bottle to keep at school. No outside water bottles (from home) are to be brought into school.
- Any child that complains of being sick or exhibits symptoms will be taken to the "isolation room". Parents/guardians will be called at once to come pick up the child. A negative COVID test must be submitted to the school before the student is allowed back in school.
- Lunch will be in the cafeteria and there will be 2 students to a table. The entire gym will be opened and used as the lunch cafeteria.
- There are arrows on the floor for children to follow to ensure social distancing.
- Only 2 children will be allowed to use the restroom at a time. They will have a "restroom pass" that they will hang outside to ensure only 2 kiddos are in at a time.

Amber attended the meeting to bring concerns about social distancing and asking how many kids are going to be in a classroom. Roxanne mentioned that it was impossible to keep 6 feet in between each student in a classroom, but every recommendation and requirement from the District is being followed. Roxanne will send out an email to every parent who has a student returning for in-person teaching with the dimensions of the classroom and how many students will be in that particular classroom.

Parent survey was discussed. Sarah Walker suggested "tweaking" the survey to make it more COVID related. Maybe keep it more simple. For example, asking parents to elaborate what we are doing correctly. The question was asked how information is getting to and from school. Roxanne mentioned that sh would look for a different kind of survey.
