Math Goal - Grades 3-6: Increase the number of students reaching proficiency by 5% as measured by the EOY RISE assessment in mathematics compared to the previous years' EOY RISE data.

Math Goal Outcome - Raw RISE scores show an 8.5% increase in student proficiency from 2021 to 2022.

Literacy Goal - Grades K-6: Increase the number of students reading at or above grade level by 5% from BOY to EOY of the year as measured by composite score on the Acadience reading assessment or Lexile Level on the RI.

Literacy Goal Outcome - Proficiency increased K-3 by 11.5% and 4-6 by 17% from BOY to EOY.
