Overnight Field Trip Request:

Vote passed with three parents and two teachers in favor of Journalism field trip to Chicago and Building America field trip to Washington, D.C. during the 2018-2019 school year.

CE Presentation:

Tara Radmall shared the presentation she will give at the parent meeting on Wed., 2/28 on the topic of CE funding. The goal of the new funding model is to help as many students with as much money as possible. A task ahead is to figure out WPU vs regular funding for concurrent enrollment. Innovations is not able to use funds out of the district CE pot (\$50-60,000/year), but use a portion of those funds migh be a "plan B" for CE student textbooks. Becky and Tara are to go through the Innovations budget line by line, then come back to present options to the SCC. Tara has planned a meeting with SLCC to discuss cost and options in future for textbooks. As an Innovations SCC we are wondering how we start the conversation to get equitable money, compared to other district schools. In the meantime, it is important to spread the message to students in a standardized way that we "may" still be able to pay for concurrent enrollment classes, but we will not be able to pay for early enrollment classes.
