The regular meeting of the Highland High School Community Council (SCC) was held at Highland High School Room C110, 2166 South 1700 East Salt Lake City, Utah convening at 6:38 AM.

SCC Items of Business:

- Principal Jenson welcomed all attendees.
- Consent agenda fundraisers were approved for both wrestling and debate.

Administration

- Principal Jenson led a discussion related to the Principal's Report for 2017-18. The council had the opportunity to review beginning account balances, this year's expenditures and ending account balances for all departments, clubs and athletic teams. Principal Jenson will follow up with the Science Department; the maximum allowed fee is being assessed to science students however the teachers have yet to spend or encumber the additional funds and the balance is currently over \$40,000.
- Individual courses and associated fees were also reviewed and compared to Board Policy S-10 School Fees Schedule for 2017-18. This schedule is the maximum fee allowed. In many cases, Highland High has been able to avoid charging the maximum fee allowed by the Board policy.
- The school administration is starting to compile registration materials for 2018-19. Visits to middle school students will take place in January.
- The State Superintendent, Sydnee Dickson, will be visiting Highland High School on Friday, November 10th.
- Principal Jenson reported on enrollment which has held steady. He looked back to 2010 when the high school had 1545 students. The numbers have grown to 1680 not including The School for the Performing Arts. East High has around 2000 students and West High close to 2700, mainly because of ELP and IB programs.
- Highland High will be SAGE testing grades 9-12 this year. The writing component will also be added to ACT testing.
